The Walk

From 21 April to 4 May 2015 Norman and a group of supporters will walk 215 miles along the Southern Upland Way in Scotland, from Port Patrick on the west coast to Cockburnspath on the east coast (go to <u>www.southernuplandway.gov.uk</u> for more information about the route). Norman will be walking an average of 15 miles a day which is quite an undertaking for anyone, let alone a person with Parkinson's. He already has the support of Scottish and Lions rugby legend, Gavin Hastings, who has agreed to accompany Norman and he hopes to have more celebrity supporters joining him along the route.
