WHAT IS CROWDLABBING FOR PARKINSON'S?

The aim is to give people with Parkinson's - and others motivated to find treatments for the disease fast - a direct voice in scientific research aimed at finding a cure.

This starts with practical involvement in suitable laboratory experiments, like a citizen science project.

But the goal is to establish a new community/company/University collaboration that puts Parkinson's patients front and centre of all research decisions.

The first pilot project with community participation will start at the end of July; based on an established drug discovery procedure that has been shown to identify drugs that reduce symptoms of Parkinson's in preclinical test systems.

Real drug candidates will be tested.

There will be a data analysis component that does not require manual dexterity.

Detailed instruction manuals and videos will be made available to participants.
