September 2019: Edinburgh Parkinson's Lecture Prof Andres Lozano




Advances in surgery for Parkinson's

Audience of 270 heard a very engaging lecture about the good longterm benefits from DBS and the prospects for a new treatment focused ultrasound.



January 2020 : Mathew Horrocks Parkinson's under the microscope – progress towards a diagnostic test



High resolution microscopy and high tech image analysis to see the early stages in the formation of neurotoxic α -synuclein protein aggregates.

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


