Parkinson's Nurse Specialists: New Appointment System

Branch Chair Stephen Brannan had a meeting with the Nurses in April and was made aware of a new 'system' for appointments, the NHS is introducing. The rationale is that when appointments are set 6/12 months in advance, there is increased potential to forget and miss the appointment. Hence, the introduction of a system where appointments are arranged no more than 6-weeks in advance.

To implement this, the Health Board is writing to patients CANCELLING their next appointments. However, at the bottom of the letter is a comment saying that the appointment *will be reinstated* 6 weeks in advance. We are aware than some Branch members have received such letters, which caused some consternation. We wonder if people perhaps had not read to the very bottom? If you receive such a communication, please do review the whole letter.
